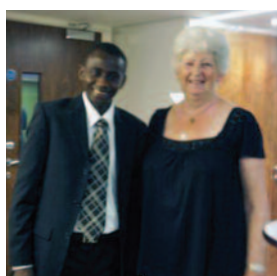


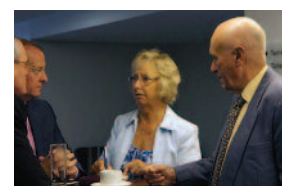


Another year ... at the AGM
